LITURGICAL MODIFICATIONS DURING FLU SEASON

In order to help prevent the spread of illness during the flu season, Bishop Jaime Soto has asked that the following temporary changes be made in our liturgical calendars

- We're asked to stop the distribution of Holy Communion in the cup.
- You are encouraged to receive Holy communion in the hand rather than on the tongue.
- The Sign of Peace should be offered without shaking hands (for example: a smile or a nod of the head while saying "Peace be with you.")
- We are asked to dispense with the holding of hands during the "Our Father."
- Those who distribute Holy Communion should cleanse their hands with antiseptic solution containing alcohol before and after administering the Sacrament.
- Ministers of the Eucharist who visit the sick and the homebound should observe these same precautions.

Please remember that the obligation to attend Sunday Mass does not apply to those who are ill. It is a sign of consideration for others that those with flu-like symptoms remain at home.

These are temporary changes which are necessary to follow until the dangers of flu season is past.
