Annual Catholic Appeal

Commitment Weekend for the 2009 Annual Catholic Appeal will take place in two weeks on Feb 21st & 22nd. Through our support we can assure the continued existence of many vital social service programs in our Diocese that assist tens of thousands of people in need, assist with the formation of Diocesan seminarians and support the establishment of new parishes in our rapidly growing areas of the Sacramento Diocese. Last year, our parish pledged \$42,000 to the Annual Appeal. Over \$36,000 was realized at the end of 2008.

Thank you to 500 plus people/families for your generous response. The Diocese would like us to increase the number of people giving this year because the needs are greater.

From last year's Appeal, 25% returned to the parish and \$9047 went to the SJV St. Vincent DePaul Society, Cordova Community Food Locker, Loaves & Fishes, Wellspring Women's Center, Sacramento Life Center, Caring Connections and families in financial distress.

This year, we hope to continue responding to people in need in a Christ-like way. The Diocese has asked that checks be made payable to St. John Vianney. Then the total amount of the appeal and the envelopes will be sent to the Diocesan Stewardship Office.

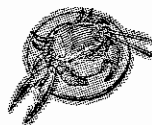
