Annual Catholic Appeal

Commitment Weekend for the 2009 Annual Catholic Appeal will take place Next Weekend on Feb 21st & 22nd. Through our support we can assure the continued existence of many vital social service programs in our Diocese that assist tens of thousands of people in need, assist with the formation of Diocesan seminarians and support the establishment of new parishes in our rapidly growing areas of the Sacramento Diocese. Last year, our parish pledged \$42,000 to the Annual Appeal. Over \$36,000 was realized at the end of 2008.
