April is Child Abuse Prevention Month

The Diocese of Sacramento mandates that all adults who work with children and youth in our parishes and schools must undergo a background check and complete child abuse prevention training through www.shieldthevulnerable.com. There are five key steps all adults can take to help prevent child abuse.

- Know the warning signs of child abuse.
- Control access to children by carefully selecting the adults who work with children and youth
- Monitor all programs for the safety of children and youth.
- Be aware of and sensitive to what is going on in the lives of children
- Communicate concerns to the appropriate person in authority.
