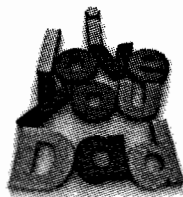

Meeting opened with gospel reading and discussion of the question of the week.

Mission statement and goals were presented to be finalized at the next council meeting on July 16th At 6:30pm.
