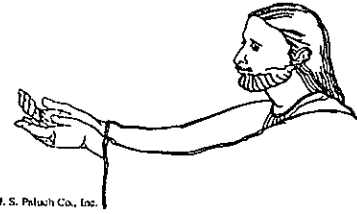

## Annual Catholic Appeal—A Success Story

As of May 20th, the Diocesan Office of Stewardship & Development has received 15,709 gifts and pledges totaling \$1,854,850 from the 2008 Annual Appeal. This represents a 103% increase in participation and a 54% increase in dollars over the 2007 Appeal.

Here at St. John Vianney we went from 55 pledges for \$17,141 in 2007 to 458 one time gifts and pledges for \$42,638. An increase of \$148% over 2007.

Twenty-five percent of the proceeds from each parish is returned to the parish to help with various charities.

The first check for \$6245 representing gifts and pledges already received by the Diocese recently came back to the parish. It was distributed as follows:
