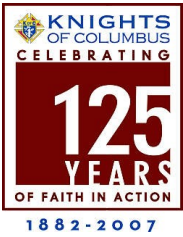

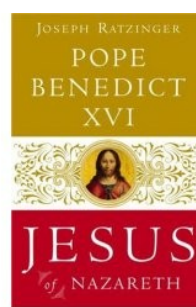
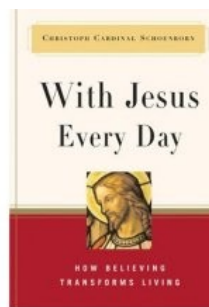
### See the film “Bella”
