**RESOLUTION REGARDING THE FOURTH DEGREE  
COLOR CORPS BECOMING A RECOGNIZED PART  
OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH OFFICIAL LITURGY**

**WHEREAS;** the Fourth Degree Color Corps of the Knights of Columbus have acted as unofficial escorts to Bishops and other high officials of the Catholic Church; and

**WHEREAS;** in this capacity they have participated in the presentation of the sacrament of Confirmation, Catholic masses, and other ceremonies and have added solemnity and dignity to these occasions; and

**WHEREAS;** the Fourth Degree Color Corps is the most recognizable group of members representing the Knights of Columbus, an organization of dedicated Catholic men; and

**WHEREAS;** these participations are not officially recognized in the official liturgy of the Catholic Church; and

**WHEREAS;** this lack of official recognition has led to confusion regarding the Corps participation in these Catholic functions;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Supreme Board of Directors of the Knights of Columbus respectfully request of the Council of Bishops of the United States that the Fourth Degree Color Corps be added to the official liturgy of the Catholic Church & their participation be officially acknowledged.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Supreme Secretary forward this resolution to the Vice Supreme Master & subsequently to the Supreme Master for action by the Supreme Council.

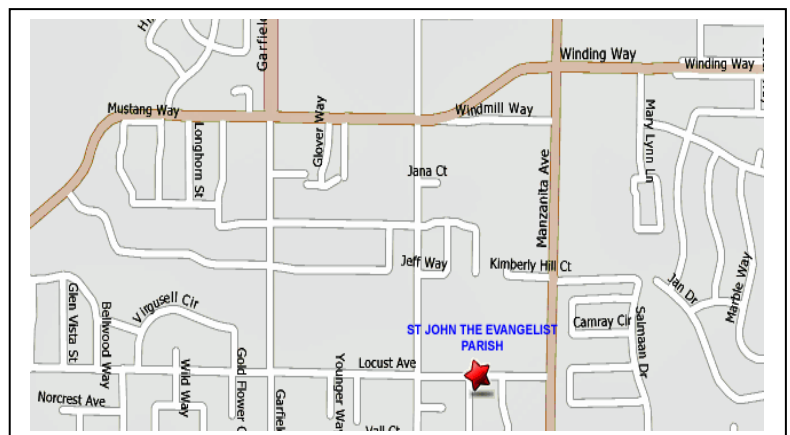

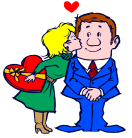

Sorry that I have not been to any meetings lately, due to my being overseas fighting for freedom. Thank all of the Sir Knights of Assembly #50, I have been receiving the newsletters & the latest version I just got on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of October. It makes me happy each month to get this information and I am glad you Sir Knights have not forgotten me over here. When I get back I will be attending the meetings and helping out with your functions. When I get back from this mission alive, I hope to see you all at the airport in Sacramento hopefully in April or May.

Here in Kabul City Afghanistan the threat rate is high due to (IED, VBIED) and (Personal IED). We are on alert 24-7. I am assigned to foot patrol where we a RED status at all fences. I ride point during foot patrol. Can you let S. K. Glenn Williams and wife know that I am doing OK over here. Also, S. K. Rositani too. Sir Knights, I have been keeping track of Council 4970 by letters or e-mails. I miss all of brothers from my Council.

I will be home for R & R on November 12<sup>th</sup> and I will be flying in. Your meetings are on the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of the month so I will be there for the November 27<sup>th</sup> meeting. I have only 16 days of R & R, so I hope to see you all on the 27<sup>th</sup>. On the 6<sup>th</sup> of October I will be 46 years old and my wedding anniversary is on the 28<sup>th</sup> of January. The Familia and I are doing well and it is great to have a beautiful wife like Debra.

We have only 6 months left here in Kabul City that is if we do not get extended on this mission, - I have been on 4 missions, and have been extended 3 times out of 4. Please keep in touch. If you can, I would be pleased if you could call my wife Debra and keep in touch with her and the family, 4970 is doing the same thing for me.

How much are my dues for the Assembly? Please tell me so I can get paid up. Please tell the members of Council 5322 and the family of S. K. Bill Walsh that he is my prayers. I am sorry I could not have been there and I wish that I could have, Bill was a great leader. I used to be a member of 5322 when Bill was there as well. I miss Bill a lot.
