A Little history of our Degree:

Excerpts taken from Patriotism and Fraternalism in the Knights of Columbus a history of the 4th Degree, written by Christopher Kauffman

The resulting Forth Degree membership expansion from its origination in the early 1900's caused a rivalry to erupt between those who existed, at that time, whose main goal was to delegitimize Catholics and the new visual organization "the Forth Degree" which represented the Catholic religion and Catholic men. At this period in history one of the main political parties of the era, the Whig party, became divided over issues of slavery and the extension into territories in the West. This resulting division caused members of this party to split and form the Anti-Catholic American party which was an offshoot of the Order of the Star-Spangled Banner. The members of this lodge-based secret society refused to reveal their aims or objectives & as result became known as the "Know-Nothing Party." Abraham Lincoln rejected this nativist party fearing that the readers of the Declaration of Independence would soon perceive its wording as: "all men are created equal, except negroes, foreigners and Catholics." An additional party also formed at this time called American Protective Association; (APA), which mimicked the same goals as the Know Nothings. Here is the oath that each member of the APA took upon joining:

"to wage a continuous warfare against ignorance & fanaticism [of the Catholics].....to retard & breakdown the power of the Pope in this country or any other.....to never employ Catholics...if I can procure the services of a Protestant...[to] vote only for Protestants... & to place the political positions into the hands of Protestants, to the entire exclusion of the Roman Catholic Church, of the members thereof and the mandate of the Pope.

The political elections of 1912 had these two groups and a third, the Guardians' of Liberty, come to focus their goals of warfare against the Forth Degree and Catholics by getting what was termed the "**Infamous Bogus Oath**" attributed to Knights of Columbus Forth Degree, published. All members of the 4th Degree were purported to a have taken this bogus oath before joining. The oath resurfaced again to haunt the degree after WW1. Here is a printed example of this bogus oath with grammatical errors included:

I, _____, now in the presence of Almighty God, the blessed Virgin Mary, the Blessed St. John the Baptist, the holy apostles, St. Peter & St. Paul & all the saints, Sacred host of Heaven, & to you my Ghostly father, the superior general of the Society of Jesus, founded by Saint Ignatius Loyola, in the pontification of Paul the III, & continued to the present, do by the womb of the Virgin, the matrix of God, & the rod of Jesus Christ declare and swear that his Holiness, the Pope, is Christ's vice regent and is the true and only head of the Catholic or Universal Church throughout this earth & by virtue of the keys of binding & loosing given his Holiness by my Savior, Jesus Christ, he hath power to depose heretical kings, princes, States, Commonwealths, & Governments, & they may be safely destroyed. Therefore to the utmost of my power I will defend this doctrine & His Holiness' right & custom against all usurpers of the heretical or Protestant authority whatever, especially the Lutheran Church of Germany, Holland, Denmark, Sweden & Norway, & the now pretended authority & Churches of England & Scotland, & the branches of same now established in Ireland & on the Continent of America & elsewhere, and all adherents in regard that they may be usurped & heretical opposing the sacred Mother Church of Rome.

I do now denounce & disown any allegiance as due any heretical king, prince or State, named Protestant or Liberals, or obedience to any of the laws, magistrates, or officers.

I do now declare that the doctrine of the Churches of England & Scotland, of the Calvinists, Huguenots, & others of the name of Protestants or Masons, to be damnable, & they themselves to be damned who will not forsake the same.

I do declare that I will help, assist, & advise all or any of His Holiness' agents, in any place where I should be, Switzerland, Germany, Holland, Ireland, or America, or in any other kingdom or territory I shall come to, & do my utmost to extirpate the heretical Protestant or Masonic doctrines & to destroy all the pretended powers, legal or otherwise.

A Little history of our Degree Continued:

Excerpts taken from Patriotism and Fraternalism in the Knights of Columbus a history of the 4th Degree, written by Christopher Kauffman

“THE BOGUS KNIGHT’S OF COLUMBUS FORTH DEGREE OATH”

I do further promise & declare that, notwithstanding that I a dispensed with to assume any religion, heretical for the propagation of the Mother Church’s interest to keep secret & private all her agents’ counsels from time to time, as they instruct me, & not to divulge, directly or indirectly, by word, writing, or circumstance whatever, but to execute all that should be purposed, given in charge, or discovered unto me by you, my Ghostly Father, or any other sacred order.

I do further promise & declare that I will have no opinion or will my own or any mental reservation whatsoever, even as a corpse or cadaver, (perinfe ac cadaver), but will unhesitatingly obey each & every command that I may receive from my superiors in the militia of the Pope and of Jesus Christ.

That I will go to any part of the world whithersoever I may be sent, to frozen regions of the North, to the jungles of India, to the centers of civilization of Europe, or to the wild haunts of the barbarous savages of America without murmuring or repining, and will be submissive in all things whatsoever is communicated to me.

I do further promise & declare that I will, when ever opportunity presents, make & wage war, secretly & openly, against all heretics, Protestants, & mason, as I am directed to do, to extirpate them from the face of the whole earth; & that I am directed to do, to extirpate them from the face of whole earth; & that I will spare neither age nor sex, or condition, & that I will hang, burn, waste, boil flay, strangle, bury alive these infamous heretics, ...(this area removed due to extremely graphic content)..... against the walls in order to annihilate their execrable race. That when the same cannot be done openly, I will secretly use the poisonous cup, the strangulation cord, the steel of the poniard, or the leaden bullet, regardless of honor, rank, dignity, or authority of the persons, whatever may be their condition in life, ether in public or private, as at any time may be directed to do so by the agents of the Pope or superior of the Brotherhood of the Holy Father of the Society of Jesus.

In confirmation of which I hereby dedicate my life, soul, & all corporal powers, & with the dagger which I receive, I will subscribe my name written in my blood in testimony thereof; & should prove false or weaken in my determination, may my brethren & fellow soldiers of the militia of the Pope cut off my hands & feet & my throat ear to ear, my belly opened & sulfur burned therein with the punishment that can be inflicted upon me on earth 7 my soul shall be tortured by demons in eternal hell forever.

That I will in voting, always vote for a K. Of C, in preference to a Protestant, especially a Mason, & that I will leave my party so to do; that if two Catholics are on the ticket I will satisfy myself which is better supporter of Mother Church & vote accordingly.

That I will not deal with or employ a Protestant if it is in my power to deal with or employ a Catholic. That I will place Catholic girls in Protestant families that a weekly report may be made of the inner movements of the heretics.

That I will provide myself with the arms & ammuniton that I may be in readiness when the word is passed, or I am commanded to defend the Church either as an individual or with the militia of the Pope.

All of which, I _____, do swear by the blessed Trinity & blessed sacrament which I am now to receive to perform & on part to keep this my oath.

In testimony hereof, take this most holy & blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist & witness the same further with my name written with the point of this dagger dipped in my own blood & seal in the face of this holy sacrament.

This violent imagery & excessive departure from the truth is a confirmation of P.T. Barnum’s dictum to the effect the **“Larger the lie, the Greater the credibility”** This oath actually made publication in the 1913 Congressional Record.

[Helmsman Editor’s notes: The militaristic uniform of the Forth Degree regalia actually opened the door for bogus oath to be written with such violent overtones, although the original intentions of the uniform regalia were only to display each Catholic Gentleman wearing such, as a Defender of the Faith. The sections of the bogus oath alluding a warlike attitude between the Forth Degree and Protestants & Masons seems very ironic being that a good portion of the organization of the Knights was borrowed from the Masons. In fact the Protestants belonging to the three groups noted above, actually practiced some of major parts of the bogus oath in regards to Catholics. The warlike attitude professed in the bogus oath above between Catholics and Protestants reminds us today of situations which took place in Ireland between Catholics and Protestants. In contrast, to the “Bogus Oath” which really illustrates the persecution Catholics were undergoing during this era, here is the original “True Forth Degree Oath”]:

I swear to support the Constitution of the United Stated. I pledge myself, as a Catholic citizen and a Knight of Columbus, to enlighten myself fully upon my duties as a citizen and to conscientiously perform such duties entirely in the interest of my country and regardless of all personal consequences. I pledge myself to do all in my power to preserve the integrity and purity of the ballot, and to promote reverence and respect for law and order. I promise to practice my religion openly and consistently, but without ostentation, and to so conduct myself in public affairs, and in the exercise of public virtue, as to reflect nothing but credit upon Holy Church, to the end that she may flourish and our Country prosper to the greater honor and glory of God.

The actual Forth Degree pledge is a clear illustration of Catholic patriotism, American citizenship and practical Catholicity.
